YOUTH PROGRAMS

ICRI empowers youth (10-24) with mentorship, STEM education, and career development to support their growth and success.

Programs include:

- Bridge to Prosperity Mentoring: Youth mentorship & life skills
- Amplify STEM After-School Program: Hands-on STEM & career prep
- Youth Workforce Development: Job readiness & skill-building

CAREER AND ECONOMIC ADVANCEMENT

Helps refugees and immigrants achieve financial independence through job training, entrepreneurship, and workforce inclusion.

Programs include:

- Employer Engagement Program (EEP): Workforce training & inclusion support
- Refugee Career Pathways (RCP): Career counseling & job placement
- Microenterprise Development (MED): Business training & microloan support

CASE MANAGEMENT

Personalized support to help refugees and immigrants access resources like healthcare, employment, and legal assistance for long-term self-sufficiency.

HOUSING

Helping refugees and immigrants secure safe, stable housing through case management, resource connections, and community support.

HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH AND PEER SUPPORT

Connecting individuals to healthcare, peer counseling, and wellness groups to promote resilience and emotional well-being.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS AND SUPPORT

Providing crisis services, education, and mental health care while partnering with organizations to ensure survivors receive comprehensive support.

IMMIGRATION LEGAL ASSISTANCE

Affordable legal assistance for family reunification, asylum, status adjustment citizenship, and work authorization to promote stability.

RESETTLEMENT AND PLACEMENT

Supporting new arrivals with housing, employment, and essential services to foster independence and long-term community integration.
