Listserv Registration Instructions | Victim Services Grants

Scope

Effective February 2026, NCC is utilizing an open-registration listserv strategy for communicating with victim services professionals regarding our general victim services grant information. This system will allow us to effectively share announcements and updates on NCC's victim services grant programs:

- Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) Services*Training*Officers*Prosecutors (STOP) federal funds
- Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) Sexual Assault Services Program (SASP) federal funds
- Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) federal funds
- Nebraska Victim Assistance state funds

This listserv will be used to advise victim services professionals of information such as application opportunities, application material updates, and other engagement opportunities to improve our use of grant funds to better serve victims of crime.

Instructions

To sign-up for notifications:

1. Go to <https://listserv.nebraska.gov/>
2. Login and/or create an account.


NOTE: You may already have an account if you are on another Nebraska listserv list or if you have an @nebraska.gov email address. (Use your email password to login if you have an @nebraska.gov email address.)

TIP: Be sure you check your spam folder if you need to create an account and are missing an account confirmation emails.

3. Search " NCC-GRANTS-VICTIMSERVICES" and click the list name.




4. Click the 3-line menu button.
