What We Do:

A Closer Look at Our Intervention Models

School Interventionist Program (Hall/Howard County Juvenile Services)

It is a school-based intervention that provides students with one-on-one support, education that will lead to positive engagements and accountability by the student, and assess student's support systems, building on identified strengths and facilitating involvement in school, family, and community activities.

This position acts as a liaison between the school, family, Diversion, and other community providers while supervising students who need academic support, specialized programming, and monitoring.

Boys Town – School Support Program

The School Support Specialist (SSS) program is a school-based intervention that promotes student safety, engagement, and well-being through positive reinforcement and social skills instruction. It aims to reduce disruptive behaviors, truancy, and emotional distress while increasing classroom participation, motivation, and parent involvement. Key activities include one-on-one and group social skills teaching, classroom observations, and family outreach to connect students with needed resources.



Who We Serve:

Reaching the Right Students at the Right Time

School Interventionist Program (Hall/Howard County Juvenile Services)

- Ages 11–18, with a focus on high-risk, pre-adjudicated youth
- Students who have low school attachment, low grades, attendance concerns

Boys Town – School Support Program

- Grades K-8, work with students, staff, and families to ensure wrap-around support and consistency for Tier II/III students.
 - Check-In- Check-Out with at-risk students.
 - Social skill groups to Tier II/III students (can be Tier 1-social emotional learning)
 - Mini Classroom lessons to general student population.

- Build healthy student-teacher-family relationships.
- Creates structured, supportive, predictable and skill-building environments.



How We Make It Happen:

Tools for Transformation




School Interventionist Program:

- Daily/weekly student check-ins.
- Home visits and transportation support.
- Team meetings with school staff, parents, and behavioral specialists.
- Referrals to services like counseling, MST, and college/job application help.

Boys Town- School Support Program:

- Individualized service delivery.
- Builds community through integration of student, parent, teacher and school.
- Leverages power of praise
- Encourages proactive vs. reactive approaches.
- Teaches replacement behaviors.



By the Numbers: *Impact You Can See*

School Interventionist Program (FY 2023-2024)

- 96% of the students who participated in the S.I. program showed school engagement improvement. 79% of the students showed grade improvement.
- Notable improvements in self-advocacy and lawful behavior.

Boys Town - School Support Program

- 290+ students served in 2023–24 (Eastern NE)
- 215+ students served in 2023-24 (Central NE)
- 225+ students served in 2024-25 (Central NE)
