SFST Refresher Information

The primary purpose the SFST Refresher Training Program is to improve the overall consistency of administration of the SFSTs by individual law enforcement officers. Officers can refresh their skills with recognizing and interpreting evidence of DWI, administering and interpreting the scientifically validated sobriety tests, describing DWI evidence clearly and convincingly and reviewing information regarding recent case law and research studies.

<u>Prerequisite</u>: SFST Refresher Training is for law enforcement officers at the Federal, State, county, and local level who have successfully completed the NHTSA/IACP-approved DWI Detection and Standardized Field Sobriety Testing Training Program. Students are also required to submit a 24 hrs SFST Basic Course Certificate when they register for this course.

Required: Participants will be required to complete an SFST proficiency test as part of the class. Participants are also required to pass an end of course written exam with an 80% or higher. Class size is limited to 18 students.

Registration deadline is January 10th, 2025. No walk-ins will be allowed.
