Leave No Gap is a four-hour intensive for agency leadership. Your agency's response to a Line of Duty Death will only be as strong as the preparation you put in before it happens. Command staff work through real policy frameworks, role assignments, and procedural protocols — and leave with the foundation for a formal LODD Standard Operating Procedure their agency can implement immediately. The session also introduces Project COMPASS, a 12-month mentorship framework pairing larger departments with smaller agencies to build regional LODD preparedness.
