Students should bring their own rifle, cased, and unloaded. Leave rifle in vehicle until told to bring it to the lab.

All tools, equipment, and manuals will be supplied.

This class will provide the skills necessary to perform armorer inspection for wear, as well as diagnose and mitigate more complex malfunctions of gas and piston AR-15 style rifles. This will include thorough measurement and gauging of wear components to evaluate dimensional tolerance as an overall annual “wellness check” of the rifle and to identify and resolve potential failures before they occur.
