

Join us for an immersive three-day First Responder FAA 107 Drone Classes at Metropolitan Community College!

This class is designed to equip emergency responders with the essential skills and knowledge to understand and effectively utilize drones in the national airspace. This course covers the fundamentals of drone uses, operation, FAA regulations, safety protocols, and best practices for aerial imaging and data collection.

By the end of the course, participants will be prepared to take the FAA UAS test to become a certified 107 compliant pilot, empowering them to support their communities more effectively in routine tasks, accident investigations, search and rescue and in a wide variety of emergency situations. **You will take the certification test on your own.**

The dates are December 17-19, 2025. The first two days are classroom instruction from 0800 – 1700 at MCC's Fort Omaha Campus, building 24 located at 30th & Fort St.). The third is from 9:00 – noon. The cost for the training is \$325.00. See registration links below.
