### HIGHLIGHTS

#### **Sworn Personnel**

3,859 full-time sworn officers with 187 vacant positions.

- 1,080 sworn officers employed full-time in Sheriffs' Departments.
- 2,198 sworn officers employed full-time in Police Departments.
- 581 sworn officers employed full-time in State Agencies.

2.0 full-time sworn officers per 1,000 people (based on a population of 1,917,926).

322 part-time sworn officers with 19 vacant positions.

#### **Civilian Personnel**

1,714 full-time civilian employees.

209 part-time civilian employees.

41 vacant positions (both full-time and part-time).

#### **Reserve Officers**

53 reserve officers.

27 agencies use reserve officers.

#### **Contractual Agreements**

26 departments reported they have contracts with communities to provide law enforcement coverage.

73 different communities are reportedly covered by law enforcement services as a result of these contractual agreements.
