Response to Child Abductions – Best Practices for Law Enforcement

July 24, 2026 / 0800-1600 hours

When a child goes missing, alarm bells ring throughout the community, creating widespread panic and a heightened sense of urgency for law enforcement. Child abductions are often a once-in-a-career event for officers, detectives, and entire agencies. In these situations, collaboration becomes essential—along with a well-managed response to media coverage. It is vital for your agency to be prepared for this type of event, to know what resources are available, and to know when to stop and ask for help.

This training provides law enforcement with a comprehensive overview of how to handle the initial response to a missing person or abduction case, emphasizing the critical first 24 hours. It also covers effective investigative techniques throughout the duration of the case to help ensure the safe recovery of the victim, identification of the suspect, and successful prosecution.

No matter how large an agency is or what resources they have available, this course equips attendees with practical tools to ensure a fast, coordinated, and effective response to one of law enforcement's most urgent and sensitive cases.
