

Basic Crime Scene Photography

This 8-hour class will entail PowerPoint lectures and hands-on experience. Students will learn basic DSLR camera functions on full Manual mode to include the application and manipulation of F-stop, shutter speed and ISO. Students will be asked to provide their own DSLR camera, detached flash, tripod and camera SD memory card to have the best experience. Students will have the opportunity to apply Manual mode techniques through basic room photography and mock crime scenes. Additional photography techniques to include injury photography, body documentation, impression photography and latent print photography may be included based on allotted class time.

Cassie Salter is a full-time Crime Scene Investigator and NIBIN Acquisition Technician for the Council Bluffs Police Department. - 2. Students will be able to accurately document a crime scene utilizing the basic DSLR camera to include overall mid-range and close photographs.
- 3. Students will be able to document other aspects in crime scene investigation to include injury photography, latent print photography and more.
