Crime Victims' Reparations (CVR)

Claims Process



Neb. Rev. Stat. §81-1809 (1) states that, "A hearing officer shall consider and rule upon any application made under the Nebraska Crime Victim's Reparations Act within one hundred eighty days after **receipt of all required information** related to the crime."

The key elements here are "receipt of all required information". The clock does not start until all information is received. It is true that with some cases, it can take 6-9 months or more to receive all of the documentation required. This is especially true for bills coming from multiple sources (i.e., several different physicians) or for care provided over a period of time (i.e., physical therapy, counseling). That said, claimants can be missing more than bills in their applications and have other supporting materials missing.
