It was alleged that Deputy Menke did personally share pornographic images of a female subject with at least one credible source without the female's knowledge or consent. An investigation into the allegation showed the allegation to be factual. Deputy Menke was terminated from his former agency for violation of policy and procedures: Rules of Conduct-Moral Turpitude. On September 24, 2021, a jury found Menke guilty of one count of Unlawful Intrusion in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 28-311.08(4), Class I misdemeanor. On December 15, 2021, Menke was sentenced to 8 days in jail and 18 months' probation.
