There will be a TCTI Tactical Shotgun Instructor Seminar at the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center in Grand Island, NB. October 04-06, 2021. This is a 3-day (24hr.) Instructor Course designed to educate and certify officers as instructors in training with the **tactical shotgun**. Classroom time, lectures and range training will be included in the 24-hour program. This course is designed with instructor development as the primary for the shotgun instructor. The 3 days training course included is to familiarize officers with a suggested course format for shotgun training, and instructor development skills. Successful course completion and certification will include:

- ** PASS/FAIL EVALUATION CRITERIA DURING THE TRANSITIONAL CORSE
- ** NUMERICAL SCORE: SHOOTING EVALUATION COURSE (80% REQUIRED)
- ** WRITTEN EXAMINATION (80% REQUIRED)
- ** ORAL PRESENTATION

This is a course designed to give the officer the most up-dated combat training with the police shotgun. The average law enforcement officer does not receive enough training with the shotgun and as a result of lack of training will not use one of the most effective weapons in certain use of force situations.

This is a fast moving survival course designed to give the instructor all background and advancements with the police shotgun. The instructors will know how to maintain the shotgun and several other important training factors:

- Survival shooting
- Safety considerations for range
- Dim light shooting
- Shooting from behind cover
- Tactical loading
- Survival stress issues with shotgun (gross motor skill training)
- Fundamentals needed to control the firepower of the police shotgun

Each student must provide the following for the instructor course:

- Police shotgun with sling
- Duty belt and handgun
- Ear and eye protection
- Ammunition:

150 rounds of light load 50 rounds of 00 Buckshot 30 rounds of slug

100 rounds for duty handgun
