



Training Center Updates

Home School Applicants

At the December 16, 2020 Police Standards Advisory Council meeting the Director of the NLETC asked for guidance on the interpretation of Title 79, Chapter 8 section 005.1H, home school high school graduates and application into certification academies. Past practice had been that an applicant who is a high school graduate of a home school was required to obtain a G.E.D. for admission.

The PSAC took action that the Director accept a transcript from a high school graduate of a home school as meeting the requirement established in Title 79, Chapter 8 section 005.1H.

Basic Seats:

Beginning in the 208th Basic (May 2020), agencies will be limited to a guaranteed maximum of **TWO** seats per basic session. This action is done to afford more agencies the opportunity to enroll students. If an agency needs more seats, the seats can be requested, but they will not be in the “top 50” slots reserved.

Uncertified New Employees

Effective January 1, 2021, when a Change in Status form is submitted for an individual who does not have Nebraska certification, that individual will automatically be enrolled in the next scheduled training session. This includes reciprocity applicants. The schedule for 2021 certification classes are listed below:
