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NEBRASKA COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE

January 22, 2016

The Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice met Friday, January 22, 2016 at 9:30 AM in the Lower Level A Conference Room, 301 Centennial Mall South, Lincoln, Nebraska. Legal notice of the meeting was published January 8, 2016 in the Lincoln Journal Star.

As amended by LB 898, 2005 Legislature, a copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for public review.

I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 9:33 AM by Acting Chairman John Freudenberg. 
