## FY2023 Juvenile Services Commission Grant Program [JS] Supplemental Funding Announcement

### OVERVIEW

Pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statute §43-2405, the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice (Nebraska Crime Commission) is pleased to announce it is seeking applications from qualified applicants in Nebraska for the Juvenile Services Commission Grant Program. Funds received through the Juvenile Services Grant Program shall be used exclusively to assist the recipient in the implementation and operation of programs or the provision of services identified in the recipient's community plan, including; Programs for local planning and service coordination; screening, assessment, and evaluation; diversion; alternatives to detention; family support services; treatment services; reentry services; truancy prevention and intervention programs; and other services documented by data that will positively impact juveniles and families in the juvenile justice system. The Commission shall award grants on a competitive basis to eligible applicants based upon criteria determined by the Commission.
