**Re: Grant Management Software Announcement**

The Crime Commission is pleased to announce the commencement of the transition of our State and Federal grant programs to a new grant management software, AmpliFund! We are confident that the transition from our current system to the new system will be smooth and anticipate you being pleased with how user friendly reporting in AmpliFund will be. The AmpliFund team will provide you with plenty of user training to prepare you for reporting in their system. Important transition dates will be shared by us to you in the coming days regarding last dates for reporting objectives and transactions in GrantVantage, last date for drawdown requests in GrantVantage, AmpliFund user training, and the AmpliFund go-live launch date.

The transition over the upcoming weeks from GrantVantage to AmpliFund will be quick with the goal to minimize impacts to your program's cash flow and general reporting. Active grants, expenditure amounts, and other existing reporting data are currently being transferred to AmpliFund and each project will be closed-out in the new system at the end of their project period. During the data transfer stage, there will be a blackout period where your agency's access to GrantVantage will be shut-off and AmpliFund will not yet be turned on, to allow our staff to manually enter budget line item amounts into the new system. This way, all projects can pick up in AmpliFund where they left off in GrantVantage.

The final day to have all drawdown requests submitted in GrantVantage will be announced soon, but could be as soon as March 15. Launch of AmpliFund for you to access projects and drawdown requests could be as late as June 1. We are hoping for the reporting blackout dates to be no longer than 30 days. Though during the blackout period, you may not have access to either reporting system, our staff will continue to issue payment for all approved transactions/drawdown requests received up to the reporting blackout period. Again, more information will be forthcoming as each stage of the AmpliFund transition timeline is solidified.
