#### **I. Call to Order**

#### **III. Introduction**

Turnbull initiated group introductions. Turnbull stated the Grant Review Subcommittee will discuss Juvenile services and Tittle II grants and the initial funding recommendations for each grant. Turnbull introduced the public members.

#### **IV. Review and Recommendations for FY 2015 Tittle II Grants**

##### **a. Summary from Humaran**

Humaran informed the Grant Review Team that a total of 35 applications were received for FY 15 Title II and FY 16 Juvenile Services. Humaran indicated that for FY 2016, Juvenile Services received \$665,470 in requests with only \$587,812 available with an overage of \$77,658. Humaran also indicated that for FY 15, Title II received \$ 508,481 in requests with only \$ 385,867 available with an overage of \$ 122,614.

##### **b. Grant Review and Recommendations for Tittle II Juvenile Justice & Delinquency Act Formula Grants**

Humaran reviewed comments from the Staff Review team that are summarized on the summary comment sheets for each grant application. There was detail discussion among the committee on each grant application. Humaran stated that there were four applications were recommended for denial. There was a brief discussion between the public members and the Grant Review team.

##### ***Motion***

***A motion was made by Hawekotte and seconded by Menzel to fund the Tittle II Grants as set forth by the Staff Review team as adjusted by the Grant Review team. Motion carried unanimously by acclamation.***

#### **V. Review and Recommendations for Juvenile Services Grants**

Humaran summarized comments on each grant application from the Staff Review team outlined on the draft Summary Comment Sheets. Humaran indicated that there were 8 applications were recommended for denial. There was detail discussion among the committee on each grant application.

***A motion was made by Speichert and seconded by Menzel to fund the Juvenile Services Grants as set forth by the Staff Review team as adjusted by the Grant Review team. Motion carried unanimously by acclamation.***

***A motion was made by Speichert and seconded by Menzel to approve the remaining funds of \$104,701 to be use for supplemental evaluation and implementation to include the YLS.***
