FY 2023 Community-based Juvenile Services Aid Enhancement (EB) Request for Application (RFA)

Pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statute §43-2404.02(3)(e), the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice (Nebraska Crime Commission) is pleased to announce that it is seeking applications from eligible counties and tribes in Nebraska.

OVERVIEW

Enhancement funding is distributed on a competitive basis to counties and tribes with a demonstrated need in the Community-based Juvenile Services Aid funding areas. This announcement is an extension of the attached FY2023 Community-based Juvenile Services Aid Request for Application (CBA RFA) released October 13, 2021. Please refer to the CBA RFA for application instructions. All CBA requirements and restrictions apply.

Applicants must be able to demonstrate additional need in the funding areas.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants are limited to individual counties, multiple counties, federal or state recognized Indian tribes, or any combination of the entities listed.

PRIORITY

Priority in awarding EB funds will be given to those counties and tribes able to justify an additional need for funds in the funding areas, prioritizing diversion, excessive absenteeism prevention and intervention, mental health services, and other services that will divert youth from the system. Other considerations when awarding funds will include the county/tribe's ability to consistently spend down grant awards; consistently meet financial (GrantVantage) and programmatic (JCMS) reporting deadlines; and commit to sustainability plans and/or match funds, such as funding personnel fringe or partially funding the programs.

July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023

DEADLINE

January 7, 2022 by 5:00 p.m. (CST)
