Question 2: Who signs the Certificate of attendance?

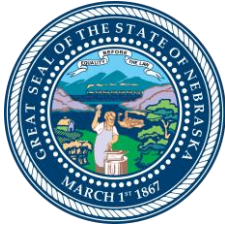
Response: The Project Point of Contact (Project Director)
