
Summarize the officer's conduct.

This case arose when Matthew Schultz, the Jefferson County Sheriff, filed a serious misconduct report with the Nebraska Crime Commission. The report pertained to allegations that Bornemeier had a Facebook page that had a picture of his girlfriend and him with what appeared to be a marijuana pipe and about 1/4 lb of suspected marijuana.
