Brandon Dolezal was fired for alleged inappropriate use of social media and had been interviewed by the Gering Police Department based upon his activity on February 23, 2021. Dolezal was charged on May 14, 2021, with several criminal counts, and additional charges following for a 2017 assault. Currently, Dolezal faces: Child enticement-electronic communication device - 1D Felony (2 counts); Commit child abuse intentional/no injury - 3A Felony (2 counts); Possess child pornography-age 19 & over - 2A Felony (12 counts). Also, Sexual assault/minor-1st degree - 2 Felony (1 count) and Sexual assault/child-3rd degree - 3A Felony (1 count) for the 2017 assault.
