ORDER FOR POST-RELEASE SUPERVISION

Defendant

This case came on for sentencing on the _____ day of _____, 20____ in open Court. The defendant appeared personally with counsel _____ . The State of Nebraska was represented by _____ . The Honorable Judge _____ presided. The Court finds that the Defendant was found guilty on the charge of _____, and has been sentenced to _____ in _____ with _____ days credit for time already served. Following release from the sentence of incarceration imposed by the Court, the defendant is hereby sentenced to a term of _____ months of post-release supervision under the supervision of the Office of Probation Administration.

During the term of post-release supervision the defendant shall:

1. Obey all city ordinances, the laws of any state, and the laws of the United States, and report any arrest, citation, or any other contact with law enforcement to the probation officer by the next regular probation office business day.

2. Avoid social contact with persons having criminal records or on probation, post-release supervision or parole, except by permission from the Court or probation officer, and not be present where illegal activity is taking place.
3. Report as directed by the Court or probation officer and permit the probation officer to visit the defendant at all times and places.
4. Reside within the State of _____ and _____ County, except as authorized by the probation officer, obtain permission from the probation officer prior to any change in address or employment, and not leave the State of Nebraska without advance written permission from the Court or probation officer.
5. Obtain and maintain suitable employment or regularly attend school/vocational training, unless exempted by the Court or probation officer, meet the defendant's family responsibilities and make no changes in the defendant's school or work program without prior consultation with the probation officer.
6. Cooperate in all matters which may affect this post-release supervision order, and truthfully answer all inquiries from the probation officer.
7. Not own or possess a firearm, ammunition or dangerous weapon.
8. Abstain from the use or possession of alcohol and controlled substances, except by prescription, and not be present in any location where the primary business is to serve alcohol, nor attend any social function at which alcoholic beverages are served, without permission of the probation officer, and submit to random chemical testing of the defendant's blood, breath or urine to determine the presence of alcohol and/or controlled substances as directed by the Court or probation officer, or a law enforcement officer who has been authorized and directed by the probation officer.
9. Submit to random searches and seizure of the defendant's person, premises or vehicle upon request of a probation officer or a law enforcement officer who has been authorized and directed by the probation officer. Pay a \$30.00 Post-Release supervision Administrative Enrollment fee, and \$_____ Post-Release supervision programming monthly fee.

11. Unless otherwise ordered, have all financial obligations and other conditions of post-release supervision completed not later than 30 days prior to the end of the post-release supervision term.

12. Follow all terms of the individualized post-release supervision plan which will be prepared prior to defendant's release from incarceration. The post-release supervision plan shall address the following treatment, counseling and education and options:

- Drug and alcohol treatment programs.
- Cognitive behavioral programs.
- Victim Empathy classes.
- Vocational training.
- Mental health treatment.
- Residence in approved half-way house or other transitional living environment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that at any time, the Court, upon application of the probation officer or the defendant, or upon its own motion, may modify, eliminate or add further conditions to the post-release supervision order authorized by §29-2262. Upon violation of any condition of the post-release supervision order, the defendant may be brought before the Court for further proceedings as provided by law.
