

Non-Offenders

(URBAN) Jail/Lock-up	NO	*Non-offenders should <u>never</u> be detained in an adult jail. *It's best to use <u>Non-Secure</u> facilities when possible with Non-Offenders.
(RURAL) Jail/Lock-up	NO	*They can be taken <u>through</u> a secure area if only for processing or ID. *After processing, they must be immediately returned to non-secure.
Juv. Det. Ctr.	NO	*They can be taken <u>through</u> a secure area if only for processing or ID.
Court Holding	Any amount of time, as long as they are S/S separated	

SIGHT & SOUND SEPARATION

- *Sight contact = clear visual contact between incarcerated adults & juveniles within close proximity to each other.
- *Sound contact = direct oral communication between incarcerated adults & juvenile offenders.
- *Sight and Sound must still apply with Adult Trustees working around juveniles or in any juvenile facility.
