Introduction

The Crime Commission surveys law enforcement agencies each year on the number of sworn and civilian personnel employed as of October 31st. In 2004 the survey covered full and part-time sworn and civilian employees as well as understaffing information. The survey also gathered information on agencies that had contractual agreements with communities or other entities to provide law enforcement coverage. 207 agencies responded to the 2004 survey.

Highlights

Sworn Personnel

3,522 full-time sworn officers with 83 vacant positions.

231 part-time sworn officers with 13 vacant positions.

2.0 full-time sworn officers per 1,000 population (based upon a population estimate of 1,739,291).

Civilian Personnel

1,356 full-time civilian employees.

272 part-time civilian employees.

47.5 vacant positions (both full-time and part-time).

Reserve Officers

117 reserve officers.

22% of the total agencies use reserve officers.

Contractual Agreements

47 departments reported they have contracts with communities, etc., to provide law enforcement coverage.
