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Introduction

The Crime Commission surveys law enforcement agencies each year on the number of sworn and civilian personnel employed as of October 31st. In 2013 the survey covered full and part-time sworn and civilian employees as well as understaffing information. The survey also gathered information on agencies that had contractual agreements with communities or other entities to provide law enforcement coverage. 162 agencies responded to the 2013 survey. ***The survey does not include personnel who are paid out of a separate jail budget.***

Highlights

Sworn Personnel

- 3,544 full-time sworn officers with 93 vacant positions.
- 968 officers employed full-time in Sheriffs' departments.
- 2080 officers employed full-time in Police departments.
- 496 officers employed full-time in State Agencies
- 3.5 full-time sworn officers per 1,000 population (based upon a population of 1,802,871).
- 282 part-time sworn officers with 9 vacant positions.

Civilian Personnel

- 1,419 full-time civilian employees.
- 262 part-time civilian employees.
- 56 vacant positions (both full-time and part-time).

Reserve Officers

- 71 reserve officers.
- 19% of the total agencies use reserve officers.

Contractual Agreements

- 46 departments reported they have contracts with communities, etc., to provide law enforcement coverage.
